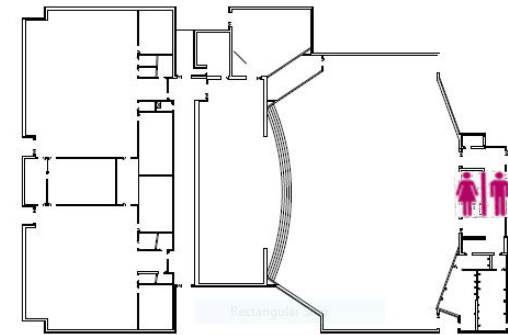
# River Ridge High School Map



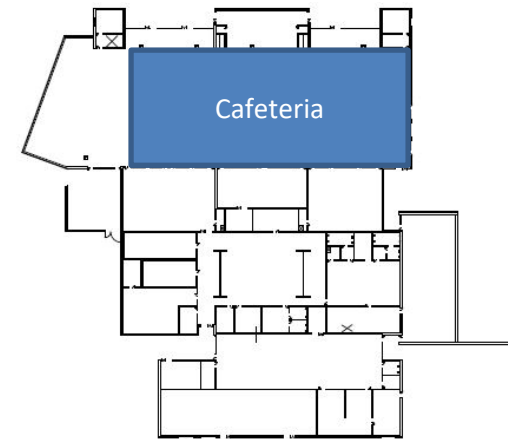
