Water covers 70 % of the earth's surface.

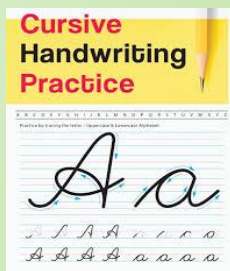
Pure water has no smell or taste.
