

PLACE Summer Camp WOW! Safety Plan

The health and safety of all our students and staff is our top priority. Therefore, our PLACE Programs will be following the Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines for COVID-19 and will implement the following safety measures for our PLACE Summer Camp WOW! We will continue to monitor government and CDC guidelines and adjust as needed.

PLACE Summer Camp WOW! Program Staff:

All PLACE Summer Camp WOW! staff will attend a mandatory Health and Safety Training that will include information about proper hygiene such as washing hands, avoiding touching one's face and social distancing.

Employees will review the self-screener prior to reporting to work each day. When the employees arrive at work, their temperature will be checked utilizing a contactless digital thermometer. Any employee displaying a temperature over 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will be directed to seek appropriate medical care and will not be allowed to work until cleared by a medical professional.

Staff will be required to wear a cloth or disposable face mask while at work.

Cleaning Procedures:

Pasco County Schools utilizes cleaning products and protocols which meet CDC guidelines and are approved for use and effective against viruses and bacteria. These cleaning products and protocols will be utilized and followed during PLACE Summer Camp WOW!

A schedule of cleaning and sanitizing has been increased for all areas used during the PLACE Summer Camp WOW!

Shared equipment will be sanitized before and after each use.

Tables, desks, phones, hard surfaces, handles, play equipment and frequently touched surfaces will be sanitized at the beginning, in the middle and at the end of the day.

Summer Camp WOW! Drop Off/ Pick Up Procedures

Drop Off

Parents will not need to leave their car for drop off. Simply follow the signs to the designated drop off/pick up area at the school. A PLACE Summer Camp WOW! Staff member will meet families at this area and check the students in each day.

On the first day of summer program, staff will be provided families with (2) two placards that display the last name of the student(s). A placard must be displayed on the dash when dropping off or picking up the student(s) for quick identification.

Each day of each week the parent will be asked the screening questions to verify that their student(s) do not have a temperature or symptoms of illness, has not traveled within the past 14 days, and has not been around anyone diagnosed with COVID-19.

Temperatures of each student will be taken daily, prior to admittance. Any student displaying a temperature over 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will be directed to seek appropriate medical care and will not be allowed admittance to the program until cleared by a medical professional.

Pick Up

Parents will not need to leave their car for pick up. Follow the signs to the designated drop off/pick up area at the school. Call the PLACE program office to advise of your arrival and a PLACE Summer Camp WOW! staff member will meet you at this area with your child(ren). If the placard is not displayed on the dash or you are not recognized by the staff member, please be prepared to show a picture ID, such as a driver's license.

Please be patient and leave extra time during drop off/pick up during the first week of program as the staff become familiar with this new process and each new family.

Summer Camp WOW! General Procedures

Parents or visitors will not be allowed inside the school building.

Staff and students will participate in frequent hand washing as part of the daily routine.

Staff and students will be reminded to participate in social distancing by staying 6 feet away from others.

Sharing of objects will be discouraged.

Hand Sanitizer dispensers will be placed in the cafeteria and individual hand sanitizer bottles will be available in the classrooms.

Students will remain with their designated group each day and will participate in program activities as a group. There will be no group mixing during the program day.

Students will eat their meals with their group and seated to provide for social distancing while in the cafeteria.
